Chris Redfearn, LL.M., FCI Arb, FSI Arb, FCI OB, FA Cost E, MRICS, MC Inst.CES, practices as an arbitrator, dispute board member, expert and consultant. Chris is a listed panel member on numerous dispute resolution institutions and arbitration centres. He has thirty nine years extensive experience working on more than eighty projects in building, civil engineering, mechanical and electrical engineering in Europe, Middle East, Africa and Asia. At present, he is a Dispute Review Expert on three road upgrading projects in Ethiopia.

Mr. Chow Kok Fong (LL.B., B.Sc., M.B.A., F.C.I. Arb., F.R.I.C.S., F.C.I.S.)

Kok Fong is a Chartered Arbitrator. He was previously CEO of Changi Airports International. Earlier in his career he was CEO of the Construction Industry Development Board, now the Building and Construction Authority, Director of Projects with City Developments and Managing Director for the International Division with the Capitaland Commercial Group. He is the founder President of the Society of Project Managers and was Chairman of the Society of Construction Law. Currently, he is Chairman of the Accreditation Committee for Construction Adjudicators and is on the ICC Committee of Experts. He has held adjunct professorial appointments with both the National University of Singapore and the Nanyang Technological University and has authored 8 books including the *Law and Practice of Construction Contracts* (which had gone into its 3rd Edition 2004) and *Security of Payments and Construction Adjudication* (2005). He is currently also one of the General Editors of the *Singapore Construction Adjudication Review*.
