Mr Silas Sng – Senior Assistant Director, OSH Policy & Legislation Branch, Ministry of Manpower

Mr Silas Sng is currently the Senior Assistant Director in the OSH Policy and Legislation Department. Silas is a mechanical engineer by training and joined the Ministry in 1997. During his years with the Ministry, Silas oversaw the general safety and health matters in the manufacturing sector as well as in the field of lifting equipment.

He was also involved in the drafting of some National Code of Practice under the auspices of SPRING Singapore.
